Excerpts from a letter from Graham Witt

"...After much prayer and soul-searching, conversations with family and friends over the last year, I have arrived at the decision to step down as the youth coordinator here at Dayton UMC. ... The timing of the announcement is important: it is not effective until after summer 2020 and our next youth mission to Atlanta. My hope is to provide ample time for a transition into the next season for our youth program. It will also be a time for contemplation as we consider leadership and structure for the youth moving forward. ...

...This decision does not come because something else is more important than the youth. Quite to the contrary, the youth are so important I feel it needs more than I can give to it at my stage in life.

I can't sufficiently thank God and the families at Dayton UMC enough for providing this path of spiritual growth in my life over the past 14 years! At the beginning, I figured it would be a year or two until DUMC found someone who knew what he/she was doing. I never set out or ever considered becoming a 'youth pastor'. But God new what I needed, when I needed it, long before I knew what He was doing. When I began this journey, without a clue as to my spiritual immaturity, I am certain no other position would have opened my eyes to Christ as much as walking with you and your youth. So thank you for being a part of God's magnificent plan. And my sincerest prayer is that this allows God to work in such grand ways with our future youth and youth leaders, that we find His way through this transition and see it for the potential opportunity it is."
